Task:

Students are expected to make a series of images that are visual responses to words.

From the list below choose 5 words, research the meaning of each and document into a sketchbook, diary or journal.

Students will develop these words into photographic images.

From each of the words there will be a contact sheet made with approximately 10-20 images per word. Stick into the sketchbook and ensure a selecting down process is made clear to establish your decision making skills. If possible print the final selected images from the 5 starting points onto quality digital paper to approximately A5 in size. (This part could be done in the first few day of school in September)

Explain why you have chosen the final images, what is it you are particularly drawn to, why are they successful, can you comment on the formal elements of your work (line, shape, tone etc) can you comment on the concept?
